Dear Year 5 Parents / Carers,

### Blists Hill – Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup> July 2023

As part of their topic on the Industrial Revolution, we are delighted to have arranged a visit to Blists Hill Victorian Town for our Year 5 children on Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup> July 2023. This is an exciting opportunity and the children will learn so much from this visit. During the day, they will explore the town and take part in a brick making workshops as well as experience what life was like in a Victorian classroom!

The children will travel by coach and will return to school for normal collection at the end of the day. Children are encouraged to dress in Victorian outfits if they would like to. Alternatively, children may wear their school uniform. It would be advisable for children to bring a light, waterproof jacket/coat and wear suitable shoes for walking / trainers. If your child is eligible for benefit related Free School Meals, they are entitled to a packed lunch provided by school. Please order this via the Gateway app by Monday 26<sup>th</sup> June 2023. Alternatively, you can send them with a home packed lunch and drink in a backpack.

The total cost of this visit is £27.00 per child to cover the entrance and transport, however, school are subsidising the cost of the trip by £7 to reduce the amount payable by parents to £20.00. If your child is entitled to benefit related Free School Meals (and Pupil Premium Funding), school have subsidised the cost of this trip by a further £5.00, leaving a balance of £15.00 payable by parents. Whilst payment is voluntary, we do rely on enough parental support to make the trip viable and enable it to go ahead. Should sufficient funds not be received, the trip will unfortunately be cancelled.

If you wish your child to participate, please give consent via the Gateway app and pay by Monday 26<sup>th</sup> June 2023.
