#### **HOW TO COME AND JOIN THE FUN!**

- Please make sure that you have emailed your name and your child's name to the class email address. If you
  have any problems doing this, please contact the school office. The class emails can be found on the school
  website under Learning / Home Learning.
- Use the class email address to ask your child's class teacher about any problems that you might have.
- Phone the school office if you do not have a device that your child can use to access Google Classroom,
- You will receive your child's log-in details and password.
- A guide to how Google Classroom works can be found under Updates and Dates/ Covid-19. It will also be sent to you via email.
- Initial contact will be made to your child by their class teacher.

### **Teaching Vidoes**

Year 5 will be trialling lesson starters which have been prepared and recorded by the class teacher next week. Over future weeks this will become a feature of some class lessons throughout the week.
