In Geography this term, we will be looking at Spatial Sense around our school. Children will use simple compass directions, aerial photographs, learn to recognise landmarks and basic human and physical features.


Maths – This term we will be learning about Place Value. The children will begin to recognise place value and addition within 10. They will do this by reading, writing, counting and comparing numbers up to 10, supported by objects and pictorial representations. Children will also learn to recognise, name and sort 2D and 3D shapes.

All children will have logins for Numbots. Using Numbots regularly will help your child to understand, recall and be fluent in mental addition and subtraction, so that they move from counting to calculating. Regular practice and play on Numbots at home independently will significantly support their progress in learning.
