## Black Country Living Museum - Wednesday 2nd April 2025

We are delighted to have arranged a visit to the Black Country Living Museum for our Year One children to support their learning in History and Design Technology. The visit will take place on Wednesday 2<sup>nd</sup> April. During the visit, the children will be explore the museum, learn about life in the past and will also take part in a brick work workshop!

The children will leave school at approximately 9.00am travelling by coach and will return to school ready for collection at the end of the day.
