### Tickets

Due to health and safety regulations, tickets will be allocated 1 per family per performance. We will not be charging for tickets but will welcome donations as well as holding a raffle and selling refreshments. Younger siblings can attend the daytime performances. However, we do ask that if they become unsettled, parents are considerate of other people in the audience and the children performing and take their young child out until they have settled.

Tickets will be available on the school Gateway app – if you would like to reserve your ticket, please confirm via the app adding the name of the person attending. Tickets must be reserved by Friday 1<sup>st</sup> December. After this date, tickets may be reallocated.

If parents would like to request additional tickets, please do so via the 'Additional Ticket' option on the app, stating which performance you would like and the number of tickets. A list will be opened on a first-come, first-serve basis and any unclaimed tickets will be reallocated according to this list. Unfortunately, we cannot guarantee that all additional ticket requests will be fulfilled.

Parents will not receive a 'physical ticket' but staff will have a list of tickets that have been allocated.

### Costumes

For children in Nursery, Reception, Year 1 and 2, staff will be sending home information about costumes this week. Children in Key Stage 2 should wear smart school uniform, accessorised with Christmas jumpers, scarves and hats for their performances!

### Evening performances

For evening performances, by bringing their child back to school, parents are consenting for them to attend the performance. If your child is not able to attend the evening performance, please inform their class teacher as soon as possible.

Biscuit / cake

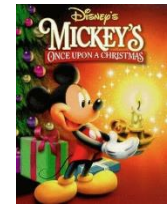
The children will be able to choose from the following films;
