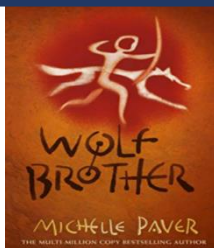


Year 5's Curriculum Newsletter – Summer Term 1 - 2024.

ENGLISH
