A word from us... Welcome back, we hope you have enjoyed your break and that the children are feeling refreshed and ready to start the new year. This half term our topic is 'Messages in a Bottle!' We will start by following the children's interest in the forest and changes we can see over the winter, animals and their habitats and how some are endangered because of climate changes. We will be taking part in the RSPB's Big School's Birdwatch and making bird feeders, as well as sharing the important message about trying to save our planet and endangered species. We will also be looking at important messages each week found in the different bottles around the classroom. These will relate to stranger danger, and e safety, having the right attitude, being honest to yourself and others and being sorry and giving forgiveness. There will be a message centre in the classroom where children will be encouraged to write messages to each other.

- This term we will continue to use our school grounds to explore the changing seasons on a Tuesday, it would be helpful if your child has a pair of wellies in school to facilitate this and is prepared for the sometimes chilly weather.
- PE will continue to be on **Tuesdays and Fridays**, please ensure that your child is wearing their active uniform.
 - We will visit the library on a Thursday, please make sure your child's library card and book are in their book bag on this day.
- To help your child succeed further, help your child with their homework given out on Fridays, and send back in on Wednesdays.
- Listen to your child read their blending books as well as using the Numbots App (Username and Passwords will be sent out)
- Share a bedtime story to help develop their vocabulary and comprehension skills.
- Please make sure your child brings their reading record and reading book in their book bag every day.
- Keep checking your child's school reading book bag, the school website and texts for updates.
