Dear Year 5 Parents / Carers,

Black County Living Museum – Wednesday 5th June 2024

As part of their topic on the Industrial Revolution, we are delighted to have arranged a visit to the Black Country Living Museum for our Year 5 children on Wednesday 5th June 2024. This is an exciting opportunity and the children will learn so much from this visit. During the day, they will explore the town, experience a mine tour as well as a Victorian lesson!

The children will travel by coach and will return to school for normal collection at the end of the day. Children should wear their full school uniform. It would be advisable for them to bring a light, waterproof jacket/coat and wear suitable shoes for walking / trainers. If the weather is warm and sunny, please ensure your child has a hat and apply suncream in the morning before school. If your child is eligible for benefit related Free School Meals, they are entitled to a packed lunch provided by school. Please order this via the Gateway app by Monday 3rd June 2024. Alternatively, you can send them with a home packed lunch and drink in a backpack.

The total cost of this visit is £20.35 per child to cover the entrance and transport, however, school are subsidising the cost of the trip by £5.35 to reduce the amount payable by parents to £15.00. If your child is entitled to benefit related Free School Meals (and Pupil Premium Funding), school have subsidised the cost of this trip by a further £5.00, leaving a balance of £10.00 payable by parents. Whilst payment is voluntary, we do rely on enough parental support to make the trip viable and enable it to go ahead. The cost to the school budget is already £236.20. Should sufficient parental contributions not be received, the trip will unfortunately be cancelled.

If you wish your child to participate, please give consent via the Gateway app and pay by Wednesday 22nd May 2024.
