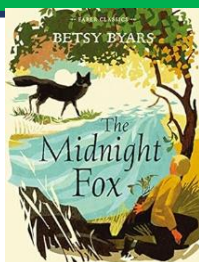
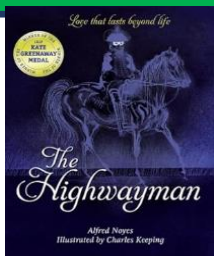


Year 5's Curriculum Newsletter – Spring Term 1 - 2024.

ENGLISH
